Pemb (Dyfed)	1501 -31	St Davids	St Davids Cathedral	39.142 Oxf	Commissioned before 1509 (doc) – the 12-bay nave ceiling timbers yielded fdrs from 1501 -31 to 1544 -74: it has pendants suspended from tiebeams of low-pitched king-post trusses. King-posts 'joggled' to receive principals. (Ceiling boards yielded earlier felling date ranges – 1434 -74 & 1445 -75).	SM 751254
